PE & Performing Arts Programs Ahead at APPS



I'm excited to continue at APPS as the PE teacher and to take on the new role of Performing Arts teacher next year. I'm looking forward to working with our students, staff, and school community.

In Term 1, alongside the regular PE program, we are incredibly fortunate to have secured an NRL incursion for the whole school, giving all students the chance to participate in a fun, high-quality sporting experience. APPS is also a recipient of the Sports in Schools Grant, which will allow students to take part in a number of free tennis workshops. We have also been lucky enough to secure a Hockey Road Show. Students will also be visited by Healthy Harold as part of our health and wellbeing program.

In 2026, our Year 5–6 students will have the opportunity to represent the school in both Summer and Winter Interschool Sports. All students will have the opportunity to participate in our whole school Cross Country and Athletics. Students aged 9 years and over will also be able to participate in Interschool Athletics and Cross Country events throughout the year. There are also opportunities for strong, competitive swimmers—please let me know if your child (9+) would like to compete in interschool swimming.

I am also thrilled to be stepping into the role of Performing Arts teacher. I can't wait to share lots of dance, drama, puppetry, and music with our students, and to support them in building creativity and confidence through performance and behind-the-scenes roles.

As part of this role, Ainslie Parklands has also been successful in applying for a Music in Schools Grant for 2026, which will be used to purchase new musical instruments and further strengthen our school music program.

It's shaping up to be an exciting year ahead, and I can't wait to get started!

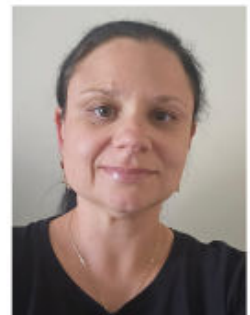

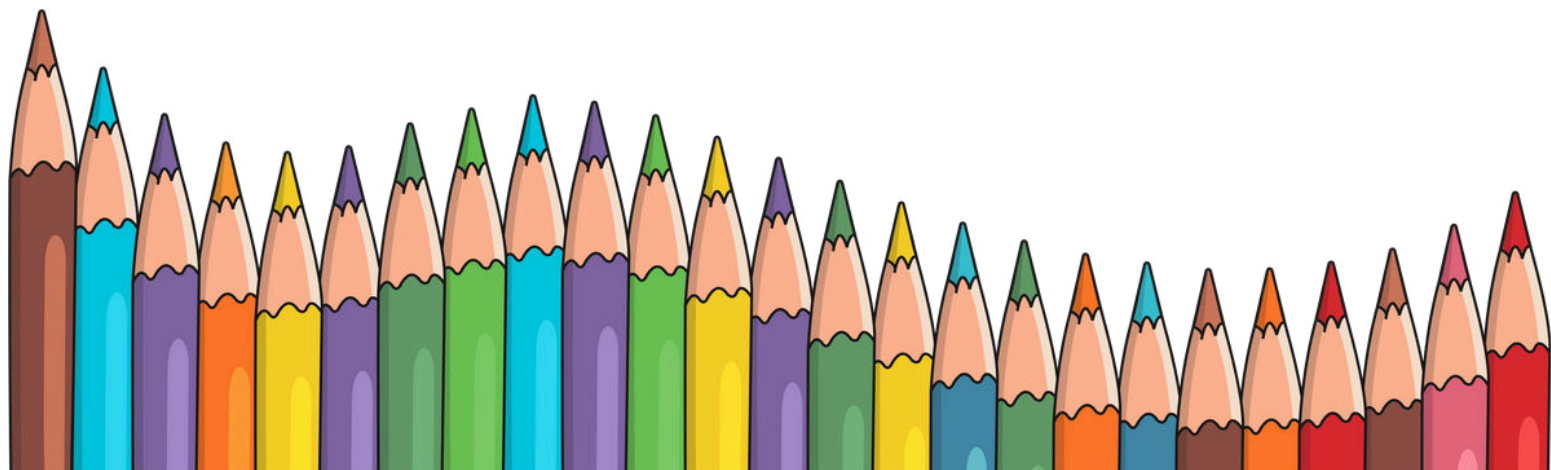
